- Trenches, Excavations
- Floor or roof openings
- Trip Hazards like Trash, debris or material
- Fall Hazards
- Guardrails or warning lines complete?
- Identify all fall exposures!

What is going on around you?

- Elevated work
- Overhead lifting, loads
- Roofing work or Steel Erection
- Walk around dangerous operations
- Share the Road!
- Never walk under elevated work, booms, buckets or loads
- See and Be Seen
- Each + every point = Situational Awareness

Assess your work area.

Identify the hazards around you.

Identify potential threats.
